Colon Cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in Kentucky. Each year, over 2,500 Kentuckians are diagnosed with colon cancer and more than 900 die from this disease. Up to 90 percent of colon cancer deaths could be prevented by following the screening guidelines and removing colon polyps before they become cancerous.*
