Builds and repairs auxiliary equipment such as fencing, signs, ramps, gates, guttering, etc. Operates and services saws, planes, drills, jointers and hand tools. Provides assistance in other skilled trades areas. Interprets blueprints and construction drawings.

UNIQUE PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

This job title requires lifting up to 50 lbs. Requires climbing, reaching, bending and stooping.

<u>TYPICAL WORKING CONDITIONS</u>: Incumbents in the job will typically perform their job duties under these conditions.

May risk electric shocks, cuts or other injuries associated with the use of power and/or manually operated tools.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Upon appointment, employees in this class may be required to maintain a valid driver's license and required to drive a licensed vehicle. This status may be necessary for the length of time in this class. If this is necessary it will be listed in the specific position description for that position. Applicants and employees in this job title may be required to submit to a drug screening test and background check.
