Coordinates the dissemination of written releases, radio releases and television videotape. Coordinates and/or appears on radio and television programs concerning the department's activities. Performs journalistic research, editing and revising of materials for publications. Works with publicity representatives of the media to promote industrial or tourism activities. Writes speeches. Creates, designs, layout and writes promotional materials of various types of brochures, pamphlets, booklets, etc. Tracks publications through the printing process. Plans, develops, implements and evaluates public relations programs throughout state government. Provides photographic services for the department. Supervises graphic arts design and layout.

UNIQUE PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

TYPICAL WORKING CONDITIONS: *Incumbents in the job will typically perform their job duties under these conditions.*

Incumbents working in this job title typically involves extensive contact with the public.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Upon appointment, employees in this class may be required to maintain a valid driver's license and required to drive a licensed vehicle. This status may be necessary for the length of time in this class. If this is necessary it will be listed in the specific position description for that position. Applicants and employees in this job title may be required to submit to a drug screening test and background check. Applicants and employees in positions which perform job duties that may require contact with offenders in the custody or supervision of the Department of Corrections or with youth in the care, custody, or supervision of the Department of Juvenile Justice must meet qualifications pursuant to the federal Prison Rape Elimination Act, 28 C.F.R.115.17 and 115.317.
