Attends trainings learning program related regulations and procedures. Under supervision, conducts routine inspections to determine compliance state and federal environmental laws and regulations; documents findings in database. Investigates complaints relative to the protection of the environment. Conducts field inspections, reports findings to supervisor, recommends corrective actions, and issues non-compliance citations. Conducts simple studies and environmental monitoring to include the collection, evaluation, and interpretation of samples, surveys, and related data. Collects and analyzes scientific data and makes recommendations for remediation of contaminants. Maintains the operation of monitoring networks to include monitoring stations, data loggers, calibrators, and periodic samplers. Conducts assessments of monitoring networks to evaluate design for redundancies and deficiencies. Reviews monitoring reports, emission reports, and test reports and issues basic inspection reports.

# <u>TYPICAL WORKING CONDITIONS</u>: Incumbents in the job will typically perform their job duties under these conditions.

Work is typically performed in an office setting. Incumbents in this class may perform work in the field with frequent travel on a statewide basis. An incumbent in this position may be subject to adverse weather conditions, exposure to snakes and insects, water-borne pathogens, broken glass, rusty metal in streams, and hazards common to operation of electro-fishing equipment, which require the following of safety procedures.

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Upon employment, employees in this job classification may be required to maintain a valid driver's license and may be required to drive a licensed vehicle. This status may be necessary for the length of time in this job classification. If this is necessary, it will be listed in the specific position description for the position at issue. Applicants and employees in this job classification may be required to submit to a drug- screening test and background check.
