In Frankfort, this year, as indicated above, we again plan to conduct Expo as normal throughout the day in contrast to an abbreviated program. For the first time the three 2010 Expos conducted at remote locations will be held only in the afternoon. These three Expos are being branded "Mini-Expos" and will be staffed solely by Authority personnel and Kentucky Marketing staff. In addition, in response to last year's traffic flow, the Frankfort Expo has been shortened by 2 hours. These actions will help the Authority reduce costs, and limit the impact on the workforce of state agencies.

Our Expo theme remains *Building Your Financial Future*. We will have two 30-minute education workshops for attendees in Frankfort, (presented both morning and afternoon) and both workshops will be conducted once at each remote site. In addition, all attendees will have an option to visit with Authority and Nationwide Retirement Solutions (NRS) marketing staff, as well as the mutual fund representatives. Furthermore, representatives from both Teachers and Kentucky Retirement Systems, as well as the Social Security Administration, are expected to participate in the Frankfort Expo.

Interested employees should get prior approval from their supervisors before attending an Expo. Employees will be granted two hours of paid time off (plus reasonable travel time) to attend one Expo. Employees will be required to present a Certificate of Attendance to their supervisor upon return to work from the Expo.
