ORDER

This matter having come before the Court upon request of the Johnson County Clerk to resolve a dispute which has arisen between the Petitioner and Intervening Defendant concerning the framing of the question on the ballot and the Court having reviewed the pleadings, having reviewed the law (KRS 132.017), having heard argument from counsel, and being otherwise fully and sufficiently advised;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the question to be placed upon the ballot shall be:

Are you for or against the Johnson County Board of Education's levy of an additional equivalent tax rate of five (\$.05) cents on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation of real and personal property to raise funds that would be dedicated strictly to new construction, major renovation of existing school facilities, and debt service?
