
**KNOTT COUNTY FISCAL COURT


WHEREAS, Zach Weinberg, Knott County Judge Executive, having found that said Petition appears proper on its face and in compliance with KRS Chapter 242.

EXECUTIVE ORDER OF KNOTT COUNTY JUDGE EXECUTIVE

WHEREAS, by proclamation issued November 21, 2016, the County Judge of Knott County orders a special local option election:

Pursuant to KRS CHAPTER 242.152 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes

WHEREAS, the County Clerk of Knott County, Kentucky has been presented with a petition signed by Knott County registered voters requesting a referendum be placed on the ballot for a wet/dry (Local Option) election, and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk of Knott County Board of Elections has certified that 25% of the total number of Knott County voters who participated in the last General Election has signed said petition as required by CHAPTER 242.020 of the KRS statute;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, as required by statute, do hereby order the date of said election shall be on the:

17th day of January, 2017

FURTHERMORE, the County Clerk shall prepare the ballots in accordance with the language as requested on the presented petition and the County Sheriff shall have this order published in accordance with the KRS Chapter and election shall take place on date ordered in Knott County, Kentucky.
