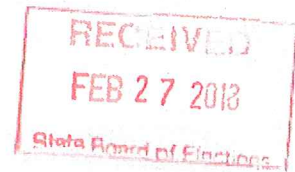

ORDER
Directing Local Option Election For
City of Hodgenville On April 17, 2018



A petition calling for a local option election on the sale of alcoholic beverages for the precincts encompassing the corporate limits of the City of Hodgenville, A101 – Hodgenville West, A103 – Hodgenville, B101 – Hodgenville East, was duly filed in the LaRue County Clerk's Office on February 16, 2018. With the aid and assistance of the LaRue County Clerk, having reviewed and certifying said petition, the County Judge/Executive has determined that the petition sufficiently complies with KRS 242 and related statutes and in accordance with the terms of said petition and KRS 242 a bond has been filed by the petitioner with the LaRue Circuit Clerk in the amount of \$8,000 to cover costs of election.

It is hereby ordered that the LaRue County Clerk and the LaRue County Board of Elections conduct such local option election in accordance with KRS Chapter 242 and related statutes, in the precincts noted above within the corporate limits of the City of Hodgenville, Kentucky on April 17, 2018 as requested by Petitioner. The Sheriff of LaRue County shall advertise this order in accordance with KRS Chapter 242 and that he post written or printed handbills of this order at not less than five (5) conspicuous places in each precinct so affected at least two weeks prior to said election.
